
This lesson will show you how to use the Import feature. The Import feature is only available in the Pro Edition of the **easyFabrics Organizer™** Module.

Importing My Inventory Fabrics


1. To begin, open **Easy Organizer Suite™** and select the **easyFabrics Organizer™** Module from the Module Selecter.



2. If you are in another module, select Modules → easyFabrics Organizer™ from the menu, or you can click on the **easyFabrics Organizer**™ icon in the toolbar.



3. To see the Import Wizard, select File → Import from the menu.



4. The Import Wizard will open.




You can either select to import into My Inventory Fabrics, My Wishlist Fabrics or from a Fabric Data Pack.

For this lesson, let's select My Inventory Fabrics. Click on the Next button to continue.

 Now the Import Wizard will ask for the file to use to import the data into My Inventory Fabrics. Click on the Browse button to navigate to a Comma Separated Values (csv) file or a text (txt) file.


For this lesson, let's use the file that you created in the Export lesson.

Click the Next button to continue.




6. The Import Wizard will now import the data from the file into My Inventory Fabrics.


Depending on how many Fabrics are in the file, this may take a while.



Importing My Wishlist Fabrics

4. The Import Wizard will now import the data from the file into My Wishlist Fabrics.





Importing Fabric Data Pack


For this lesson, let's use a test Fabric Data Pack file.

Click the Next button to continue.




4. The Import Wizard will now import the data from the file into the Fabrics system table.


Depending on how many Fabrics are in the file, this may take a while.
